What is Matariki?

Matariki is a star cluster that appears in the early morning sky in Aotearoa during the mid-winter months. The star cluster is well known worldwide and can be seen around the globe at different times of the year. It is one of the brightest clusters in the sky, containing hundreds of member stars.



This year, the Government has committed to ensuring mātauranga Maori is at the heart of celebrations of the Matariki public holiday. It will be a time for Remembrance — Honouring those we have lost since the last rising of Matariki.

The first public holiday to celebrate Matariki will be on **Friday 24**th **June**, marking the reappearance of the constellation.
