

DRIVING AROUND SCHOOL GROUNDS AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

There has been an increase in the number of parents driving into the school car park area or stopping in front of the gate to drop off or collect their children. The congestion this creates is a hazard and safety issue waiting for an accident to happen. Please do the right thing and keep all of our students safe.

<u>DO NOT</u> drive in the car park or park in front of the gate, find a safe area to park and encourage your children to use the pedestrian crossing. We have trained Road Patrollers at the pedestrian crossing every day to help get your children to and from school safely.

WET WEATHER PROTOCOL

- If it is wet, we will open the gates at 2:45pm for parents to come in and collect children directly from classrooms at 2:55pm.
- Children walking home will be released at 2:55pm.
- Children waiting for older siblings from High School will wait in class.
- After 3:10pm, children not picked up will be sent to the school office.
