POSSIBLE STRIKE ACTION



SAMOA LANGUAGE WEEK

Next week is Samoa Language Week. The theme for Samoan Language Week 2023 is 'Mitamita i lau gagana, maua'a lou fa'asinomaga' which means 'Be proud of your language and grounded in your identity'.

This year's theme focuses on the importance of the Samoan language and identity. It impresses on us the need not only to understand the Samoan language but to also use it as much as possible. When you are proud of your language and can speak it, you will also be more grounded in your identity as a Samoan. Mitamita i lau gagana, maua'a lou fa'asinomaga encourages Samoan language pride in four key areas:

- 1) Be proud of your ancestral language
- 2) Be proud of your spiritual language
- 3) Be proud of your language in your families
- 4) Be proud of your written language



To celebrate Samoa Language Week, students can come to school dressed in their Samoan traditional dress on Friday 2nd June.


