SAFE SPEEDS AROUND SCHOOLS

A 30km/h speed limit has been implemented on roads around our school from the 26th of January 2023. The school community asks that you respect this speed limit to ensure the safety of children walking and biking to school.

The purpose of a safe speed limit:

- Setting safe and appropriate speed limits outside and surrounding schools improves children's safety. If parents believe their children are safe on the way to school, they will allow them to walk and cycle to school more often.
- The internationally accepted speed to greatly reduce the chances of a person being killed or seriously injured is 30km/h.
- Slow and safe speeds deliver many benefits to Auckland communities including healthier environments, thriving town centres, safe streets for walking and biking, improved air quality, and lower carbon emissions.
