DRIVING AROUND SCHOOL GROUNDS AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

The traffic congestion seems to worsen day by day and our roads are becoming very unsafe for our school children. The increased number of parents stopping in front of the gate to drop off or collect their children and driving on the footpath blocking students walking to and from school adds to the congestion, creating a hazard and safety issue waiting for an accident to happen. There is also an increase in parents NOT using the pedestrian crossing when crossing the road with their children. Children are now following suit. Let's be good role models and do the right thing by teaching our children to use the pedestrian crossing and safely cross the road.

<u>**DO NOT**</u> drive in the car park or park in front of the gate, <u>**DO NOT**</u> drive onto the footpath and block the children from walking, find a safe area to park and **encourage your children to use the pedestrian crossing**.

We have school staff and trained Road Patrollers at the pedestrian crossing every day to help get your children to and from school safely.
