Tomorrow is the last day of Term 1. School will close at the earlier time of 2:00pm.


Please arrange to have your child/ren collected at this time and advise after school care of our early finishing time.

TERM 1 ATTENDANCE

At Leabank School we recognise that attending school regularly and on time has a positive impact on learning, progress and therefore the best life chances for our students. Excellent attendance and punctuality is the key to our student's success. Therefore, we must ensure that attendance and punctuality are the highest they possibly can be in order to prepare our students for their future adult life.

We love it when our students come to school and we worry when they don't. We know some absences may be due to illness or challenges experienced in school or the community. It may be stressful getting back into a routine of attending school every day but we need you to please do your best to ensure that your child attends school every day, setting them up for a good education and ensuring your child has success at school.

The research shows that more frequent non-attendance is associated with worse wellbeing outcomes, including schoolwork-related anxiety, decreased sense of belonging, fewer friendships with peers, exposure to bullying, and feeling like teachers are being unfair.
