They have transitioned to their year 1 class with Miss Ansin, Miss Neal and Mrs Delany.

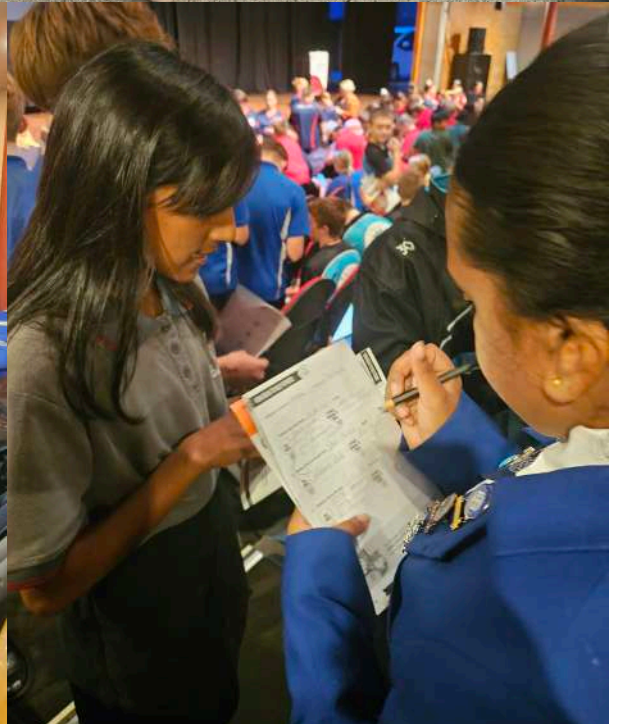




## FUTURE YOUNG LEADERS CONFERENCE
