MĀNAWATIA A MATARIKI

What is Matariki? Matariki is a star cluster that appears in the early morning sky in Aotearoa during the mid-winter months. The star cluster is well known worldwide and can be seen around the globe at different times of the year. It is one of the brightest clusters in the sky, containing hundreds of member stars.

This year, Leabank School celebrated Matariki with three days of fun, learning and togetherness inspired by the Māori New Year. Our celebration kicked off with a Whole School Soup Wednesday, where our tamariki generously brought bags of kumara, potatoes and other vegetables to contribute to a delicious shared soup. This special day reflected the spirit of kotahitanga – unity and working together. Thursday last week, students came dressed as their favourite Matariki star, showcasing their creativity and knowledge of the Matariki cluster. From colourful costumes to thoughtful symbolism, it was a joy to see their interpretations come to life. We wrapped up our celebration with our very own Matariki Disco, where students let loose and danced their hearts out in celebration of the Māori New Year. A big thank you to our staff, students and whānau for making this a memorable celebration.


